FOX CHAPEL BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING HELD APRIL 21, 2025

Mr. Bennett called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

MINUTES

Mr. Lauer moved that the March 17, 2025, meeting minutes be approved. Ms. Monroe seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

RESIDENT COMMENTS

Jacqueline Gillespie, 758 Fairview Road, stated that if the private drive she lives on is named Heritage Lane, which is one of the suggestions submitted by a neighbor for the lane name, the residents along the lane should have different numbers than other Heritage Lane/Road/Drive locations in other zip codes around Allegheny County.

Kathleen Wallach, 770 Fairview Road, stated she is concerned that if Heritage Lane is chosen, there may be confusion, as Heritage Lane is also located in the 15237 zip code, which is one number off from their current zip code of 15238.

PARK COMMISSION

Chairperson Wesley Posvar summarized the Park Commission meeting held on Monday, April 14, 2025. He stated that Victor White's Eagle Scout Project to save Hemlocks in Borough parks from Hemlock Woolly Adelgid (HWA) was progressing well. He said Victor identified 589 infected Hemlocks in Borough parks, which has assisted Public Works employees trained to treat the infected trees via trunk injections. As part of Victor's project, he will release beetles that serve as a natural predator to HWA this spring on two infected trees in Salamander Park and continue to monitor the treatment.

Mr. Posvar said another Eagle Scout Project was proposed to the Park Commission at the April meeting. The proposed project is for an improved connector trail from Country Day School to Riding Meadow Park, utilizing the existing trail.

Fox Chapel Borough and O'Hara Township Joint Inaugural Trail Run

Mr. Cohen stated that the Park Commission requests Borough Council's approval to proceed with a joint planning meeting between Fox Chapel Borough and O'Hara Township for the Joint Inaugural Trail Run, which will take place in mid-to-late September.

Mr. Lauer moved to approve the inaugural trail run and the joint planning meeting between Fox Chapel Borough and O'Hara Township for the inaugural trail run. The motion was seconded by Mr. Leech and passed unanimously.

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ENVIRONMENTAL ADVISORY COUNCIL (EAC)

Chairperson Austin Henry summarized the Environmental Disturbance Application No. 25-02, 120 West Chapel Ridge Road, proposed new single-family dwelling construction.

Mr. Henry stated that the EAC recommends approval of Environmental Disturbance Application No. 25-02 as submitted, including the granting of a waiver for a level spreader, a waiver for the disturbance of steep slopes with moderate risk up to 32% where the ordinance limitation is 25%, the revised drawing submitted by the engineer on April 16, 2025, showing the 84" detention tank moved as close to the proposed 1170 contour as possible and the level spreader outlet as close to the 1160 contour as possible, and contingent upon the satisfaction of the standard requirements outlined in the LSSE letter dated April 8, 2025.

Mr. Leech moved to approve Environmental Disturbance Application No. 25-02 as submitted, along with the waiver for a level spreader, a waiver for the disturbance of steep slopes with moderate risk up to 32%, the revised drawing from the engineer from April 16, 2025, and all the other requirements outlined in the LSSE letter. Mr. Harrison seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

Mr. Henry summarized the Environmental Disturbance Application No. 25-06, Lot 621-P-10 Old Indian Trail, proposed new single-family dwelling construction.

Mr. Henry stated that the EAC recommends approval of Environmental Disturbance Application No. 25-06, as submitted contingent upon adding five deciduous hardwood trees to the replanting plan, ensuring the correction on sheet CW502 on the orifice plate detail of the lower orifice at elevation 1147 is marked as a 0.5" diameter orifice as opposed to the current designation on 6", and the satisfaction of the standard requirements outlined in the LSSE letter dated April 11, 2025.

Mr. Leech moved to approve Environmental Disturbance Application No. 25-06 as submitted, with the contingencies listed in the EAC's recommendation. Mr. Lauer seconded the motion.

Mr. Leech commended the EAC and Mr. Henry for all their work and for educating the Council and those attending the meetings on how the EAC evaluates applications. He stated that it was very helpful. The motion passed unanimously.

POLICE REPORT

Sergeant Clark stated that with the weather improving, officers will patrol Borough roads, make traffic stops, issue warnings and citations, and check Borough parks. He said the department would be more visible.

FIRE REPORT

Mr. Pohl stated that March was an abnormal month for the department's call volume. He said that many of the additional calls were for brush fires and weather-related issues.

FOXWALL EMS REPORT

Chief Shopland announced that the 2025 Foxwall EMS subscription mailer program will begin soon. The program, he said, directly fuels Foxwall's mission by supporting essential operating costs while protecting residents from unexpected medical expenses with best-in-class member benefits.

Chief Shopland also said that Foxwall EMS would begin a capital campaign to replace the 2008 ambulance and help upgrade its facility. The campaign will run for one year and total \$500,000.

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PUBLIC SAFETY ASSISTANCE COMMITTEE (PSAC)

Ms. Monroe summarized the PSAC meeting held on March 26, 2025. She said the PSAC reviewed the police department's training schedule and needs, and the committee recognizes the importance of training and supervision. She also said that the PSAC will begin holding quarterly meetings instead of monthly.

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT

Mr. Kurpakus stated that the contractor planted large-diameter trees at McCahill Park and will complete the fencing and ballfields this week or next. He said that PWD will install trash cans, replace the split-rail fence around the park in areas, and perform other maintenance.

ENGINEERING REPORT

Mr. Bennett noted that the Borough was awarded a \$50,300 GROW Grant for the 2023 Sanitary Sewer Lining and Repair project and a \$238,800 GROW Grant for Phase I and Phase II of the Old Mill Road—Sycamore Run Sanitary Sewer Replacement. He thanked LSSE and Borough staff for their work in obtaining these grants.

TREASURER REPORT

Ratification of Payments – March 2025

Ms. Monroe moved to ratify the payment of bills for March 2025 General Fund Vouchers 5658 - 5744 for \$585,853.28. Mr. Colton seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

Naming Two Private Lanes Off Fairview Road

Mr. Lauer moved to approve the selected private lane name for current address numbers 724, 728, 730, 732, 734, 736, and 738 Fairview Road to Flower Hill Lane. Ms. Monroe seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

After a discussion regarding a name for the private lane for current address numbers 750, 758, 760, 764, and 770, Fairview Road, Mr. Colton moved to table the agenda item to allow more time to discuss with the residents along the lane a way for them to come up with a name they can all agree upon as there was currently not a consensus among all the residents of the lane. The motion was not seconded.

Mr. Bennett moved to approve the selected private lane name for current address numbers 750, 758, 760, 764, and 770, Fairview Road to Rhodora Lane. Ms. Monroe seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken as follows:

The motion carried with five members in favor of the name change and two against.

Ronald Bianchini, 724 Fairview Road, asked if the households along the private lanes would receive new address numbers. Ms. Peterson stated that all households will be issued a new address number. He also asked if there was a timeline for when this would become effective. Ms. Peterson said a letter would be mailed to all affected residents on Fairview Road, alerting them of their new address. This letter will include information on the steps the Borough will take to assist in the address change and what the residents need to do. Another letter will be sent closer to the effective date for the address change that will serve as official notice of the new address. Ms. Peterson stated the effective date will be sometime in July.

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Resolution No. 710 – Phase III – Fox Chapel Road – Sycamore Run Sanitary Sewer Replacement PA Small Water and Sewer Program Grant Application

Ms. Monroe moved to adopt Resolution No. 710, which designates Gary J. Koehler, Borough Manager, and Shawn M. Peterson, Borough Secretary, as the officials to execute all documents and agreements between the Borough of Fox Chapel and the Commonwealth Financing Authority to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant. Ms. Hanna seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

CONTRACT AWARD

2025 Roadway Improvement Program Contract No. 25-R01

Mr. Bennett moved to award the Base Bid and Add Alternate No. F-A1, F-A2, and F-A4 of Contract No. 25-R01 – 2025 Roadway Improvement Program to Shields Paving Inc., totaling \$1,371,371.00. Mr. Lauer seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. This amount includes \$14,093.50 for Utility Patches, which respective utility companies will reimburse. Therefore, the total to be paid from the Road Paving Budget will be \$1,357,277.50.

SHACOG Purchasing Alliance 2025 Spring Commodities

SHACOG received bids for spring commodities. Council was informed that the contracts are recommended to be awarded to the low bidder in most cases. The primary exceptions are where the low bidder cannot manufacture to the Borough's specifications, material quality, and availability, or where the added travel time to the low bidder's site would more than offset any cost savings.

Mr. Bennett moved that Borough staff be authorized to enter into contractual agreements for commodities the Borough requires with the vendors who can provide them. The motion was seconded by Mr. Colton and passed by a unanimous vote. *(It is understood that the Borough is not compelled to purchase its requirements for these commodities from these vendors so long as alternative purchases meet legal requirements.)*

Roadway Aggregates Contract No. 25-RA1

Mr. Bennett moved to award the Roadway Aggregates Contract No. 25-RA1 to Lindy Paving as the low bidder for No. 2A Limestone and AASHTO No. 57 Gravel, as highlighted in the bid tabulation. The motion was seconded by Mr. Leech and passed by a unanimous vote.

Mr. Bennett moved to award the Roadway Aggregates Contract No. 25-RA1 to Allegheny Mineral Corporation as the low bidder for No. 57 Limestone, No. 1 Limestone, R-8 RipRap, AASHTO No. 8 Limestone, No. 8 Pea Gravel, Fine Mason Sand, and Fill Sand, as highlighted in the bid tabulation. It is recommended that No. 2A Limestone be awarded to Allegheny Mineral Corporation, depending on material availability. The motion was seconded by Ms. Monroe and passed unanimously.

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CivicPlus Agenda Meetings Management and Municipal Website Upgrade

Mr. Lauer moved to award CiviPlus the Agenda Meetings Management and Municipal Website Upgrade via the GSA Contract GS-35F-0124U at \$20,627.25. \$4,125.45 will be paid in 2025, with the remaining \$16,501.80 to be paid in 2026. Ms. Monroe seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Community Events

Ms. Peterson stated the Fox Chapel Police Bicycle Rodeo would take place on Saturday, May 17, 2025, from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Fox Chapel Presbyterian Church parking lot.

She also stated that Fox Chapel Day will be held at McCahill Park on Saturday, June 14, 2025, from noon to 4 p.m. Ms. Peterson said that the Borough will begin a new program called K9 Officer for a Day in conjunction with other community events: Borough staff, Sgt. Sorg and Officer Zac Luffy will work with the Humane Animal Rescue of Pittsburgh for the inaugural event, which will take place at Fox Chapel Day 2025.

Ms. Peterson thanked Ethan, Avery, and Kabeer for all their help in organizing the Local Government Week Roundtable Discussion on April 14, 2025, at the Cooper-Siegel Community Library. Mr. Bennett asked if this event will be held yearly. Mr. Kolek stated that it is a program that can be built upon and done yearly by the Junior Council Person Program members. Mr. Colton said he spoke with panel members after the event, who all said it was a great event and hoped that the JCP Program would do it again. He encouraged them to reach out to other organizations in the community to assist with publicizing and promoting the event in the future.

Tree Canopy in Fox Chapel

Mr. Colton stated he received a map from Tree Pittsburgh, which studied the tree canopy in the Borough of Fox Chapel from 2015 to 2020. The study showed a 2% canopy loss in the Borough. He asked Tree Pittsburgh if they would be performing a study for 2020 to 2025. Tree Pittsburgh stated that, given the amount of open-source materials available, they are questioning whether it is worth raising the funds needed for a new study. It may be possible for the Borough and other municipalities to do these types of studies independently through the EAC, volunteers, the Park Commission, or as an Eagle Scout project.

Mr. Bennett asked if Mr. Colton could ask Tree Pittsburgh what would be involved in obtaining the open-source materials and how the study could be performed.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 7:59 p.m., the Borough Council adjourned into Executive Session to discuss a personnel matter. At 9:51 p.m., the meeting was reconvened.

With no other business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 9:51 p.m.
